HOLIDAY RESERVATION INFORMATION

TICKETS for Beth Evergreen MEMBERS: As in previous years, all adult CBE members, whose accounts are current as of 8/15/2010, will receive their High Holiday tickets in the mail by September 1st. One ticket per adult is good for all services including Erev Rosh Hashanah, Rosh Hashanah Day 1, Kol Nidre, and Yom Kippur Day.

Children and Adult Children:

ADULT CHILDREN - As in past years, tickets will not be issued for children under 18 (they do not require tickets). If you have children 18-21, please complete the Member Request for Family Ticket Form (no charge). For children over age 22, you will need to request tickets as outlined for family guest tickets.

YOUNG CHILDREN - For young children participating in our childcare activities, registration is needed so we can plan enough food and staff to meet your children's needs adequately. Please complete the "**Children & Youth Form**" by August 25th.

Ticket Requests for FAMILY GUESTS of Beth Evergreen Members:

For those who would like additional tickets for immediate family members (defined as grandparents, parents, siblings, and adult children), requests for up to two guest tickets should be made through the CBE office by August 5th using the **Member Request for Holiday Ticket Form**.

* These two guest tickets are complimentary and may be used for all High Holiday services.

* As in past years, we are, however, requesting a donation of \$125 per adult ticket to help offset our High Holiday expenses.

* Guest ticket availability is on a first-come, first-served basis, and seating is limited due to the weekend-heavy schedule of this year's holiday services.

* After August 5th, remaining seats will be made available for Tishrei memberships.

TISHREI MEMBERSHIPS

Our policy is to make available a limited number of "Tishrei" memberships (one-month holiday memberships that enable people to attend the High Holy Days at Beth Evergreen). These are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis, based on availability.

Beth Evergreen High Holidays 2010 Information for CHILDREN and YOUTH



Beth Evergreen's High Holiday Youth Program has been designed to give your child (toddler through 3rd grade) an opportunity to participate in an enriching, hands-on experience. (Grades 4-7 will have separate youth programming; details to follow.)

The program will start and finish simultaneously to the adult morning and evening services on Erev Rosh Hashanah, Rosh Hashanah Day 1, Kol Nidre and Yom Kippur Day Services. A small childcare program will be available during Yom Kippur afternoon services.

Children will participate in art projects, stories, song-sessions, snacks, and holiday prayers.

This program is not meant to replace the 3PM Children's service on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur Days, but is an additional experience that will allow parents to attend the adult worship services.

Please return forms by August 25th to ensure proper staffing and group placements. There is a \$5 charge per child per holiday experience*. Please note: a maximum of \$25 per family will be charged.

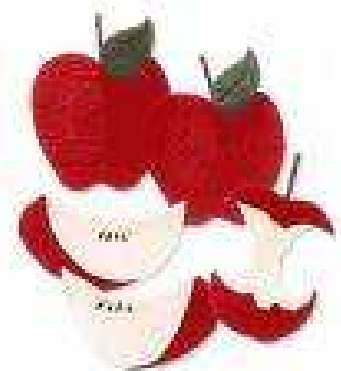
